



## POSTSECONDARY ENROLLMENT

Enrollment in a postsecondary institution is the first step to degree or credential attainment. This indicator shows the number of the state's high school graduates who matriculate into postsecondary education. This number may include students who attend a state's two-year and four-year systems, public and private institutions, and in-state and out-of-state institutions.

Because definitions and denominators vary by state, differences in states' definitions and denominators are included. Every state should disaggregate these data by subgroup. Click into each state/indicator combination on the [home page](#) to see each state's subgroup data.
